Hoopa Tribal Forestry Fire Salvage

The recent Bald Hills Fire has killed a number of trees that are to be salvaged. This is an emergency operation and will happen at the earliest possible date. The salvage area is located in portions of Sections 28 and 29, T9N, R4E, H.B.M. Approximately 62 acres will be salvaged. Units are all located on rocked roads in the upper portion of the Hog Ranch Creek watershed. This project will be an equipment based operation and moderate ground disturbance is expected. However, all operations will be in accordance with the Tribe's Forest Management Plan. If you have concerns about the area being considered for harvest, please visit the Hoopa Tribal Forestry Department, where maps and detailed information is available. Tribal Forestry will have an Interdisciplinary meeting Wednesday October 8 at 9:00 at the Forestry conference room where the public will be welcome.
