



The data depicted on this map as points represent global positioning system (GPS) coordinates of 16 bears that were fitted with GPS collars starting in the summer of 2003 and ending in the summer of 2007. Approximately 28,000 total points were recorded each capturing not only the bears position, but both the bears speed and level of activity. Points of the same color represent one individual bear and their home range. The data indicates that some bears may stay within one particular area throughout the year while some bears may migrate to areas off the Reservation depending on the season.
